



**The Will of God – Master Class Study Questions**  
**Session 4 (Pastor Gary Brandenburg)**

1. How many times does Paul use the word “one” in **Ephesians 4:4-6**? What does this tell us about the will of God?

2. **Ephesians 5:18** is a command, “keep being filled by the Holy Spirit.” According to Jesus’ words in **Luke 11:9-13**, how can I be filled with the Holy Spirit?

3. What are the results of being filled with the Holy Spirit in **Ephesians 5:19-6:4**. Read **Colossians 3:16-17** and notice similar words. But the command in **Colossians 3:16** is different. What is required of the Colossians to get the same results as the Ephesians?

4. In **1 Thessalonians 4:3**, Paul defines the will of God this way: “This is the will of God, your sanctification.” What is your understanding of the word, “sanctification?”

5. God’s will is that we make steady progress toward being the person we were created to be. According to **Ephesians 6**, what or who is the greatest threat to our progress? What does Paul say we should do about “the schemes of the devil?”
